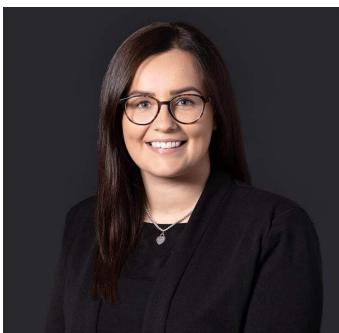

They were also ranked highest in the region for their antenatal check-ups and care provided during pregnancy and in the ward and at home after birth.
