Emma Capper said: "I am thrilled to take up the role as practice head across the firm and I look forward to spearheading the growth of the employment practice even further."

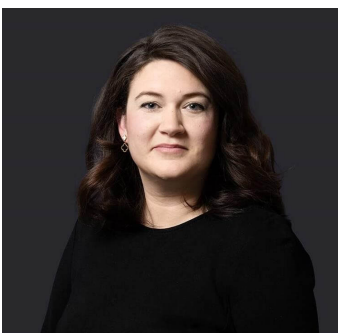
Emma has extensive experience advising UK and international businesses on all aspects of employment law, including large scale restructuring, employment disputes, board level exits, cross-border projects and investigations.
